Meet & Eat has been providing a service to families in Chesham since Easter 2018. The URC were keen to provide a safe and fun environment for families trying to manage on a tight budget during the holidays, thus began our Meet & Eat kitchen sponsored by MakeLunch. Last year alone we fed almost 500 children and 300 adults over 21 sessions throughout the holidays.

All of our lives have changed in 2020 and Meet & Eat has changed how we operate to enable us to carry on serving families in Chesham. As we can no longer provide our usual sessions we have instead provided craft boxes over Easter and are involved in the BFNCTA (Big Friday Night Community Take Away) ensuring many of our families receive a free home cooked meal delivered to their door once a week. This will carry on over the summer holidays. We will also be providing food parcels to our families containing two days worth of food to include, fruit, veg, dairy and dry goods for the six weeks of the holidays.

This work is only made possible by our many volunteers, generous donations and sponsorship. We would like to thank all our anonymous donors as well as Chesham Town Council, Rotary Club and Tesco for their kind sponsorship and we hope to continue with this invaluable club for the foreseeable future.
